## Statement of Recycled Content for

### Brass Coil, Sheet and Plate

This is to certify that all Revere's brass sheet, strip and coil are made in conformance to Standard ASTM Specifications. This is to further certify that Revere's brass contains **85% to 90%** recycled copper and zinc. All Revere brass is made from a combination "number 1, bare-bright" scrap and the highest quality brass scrap. Coated wire and/or other materials that emit VOC's or similar compounds are never used during melting or fabrication (rolling). Revere's brass products are completely recyclable as post-consumer or post-industrial product.

The recycled brass Revere uses to produce its brass products are obtained from both industrial sources (i.e., wire mills, metal stamping and fabricating plants, etc.) and metal scrap dealers who have satisfied Revere's quality control standards.

Market conditions dictate when and where recyclable brass is available. Nevertheless, well over 75% of this material is obtained from sources within 500 miles of our plant. Most of these facilities are located in New York State, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, and Southern Ontario. Smaller amounts of copper are obtained from facilities in Southern Maine, New Hampshire, plus the "manufacturing belt" that encompasses Detroit, Toledo, and Cleveland. Due to the competitive nature of the scrap market we cannot disclose individual locations (or cities) from which we obtain brass.

Depending upon market conditions the exact percentage of recycled metals and mix of post-consumer and post-industrial material will vary. Since market conditions vary constantly Revere cannot accurately identify the ratio of post-consumer to post-industrial copper in a given order. Therefore, Revere uses the conservative position that its copper contains only post-industrial material.

All Revere's brass products are made in Rome, NY - approximately 95 miles west of Albany, NY.
