

Revere Copper Products, Inc.



Statement of Recycled Content

This is to certify that all Revere's architectural copper sheet, strip and coil are made in conformance to ASTM B 370 – Standard Specification for Copper Sheet and Strip for Building Construction. This is to further certify that Revere's standard and pre oxidized architectural coppers – **Classic Copper**, **The Liberty Collection**, and **Continental Bronze** – contain **95% to 99%** recycled copper.

A portion of the tin/zinc alloy coating on Revere **FreedomGray™** is recycled material but, since the percent varies Revere certifies the recycled content of 16-ounce **FreedomGray** is **87.5% to 92.2%**; the recycled content of 20-ounce **FreedomGray** is **89.0% to 93.6%**.

All Revere copper are made from “number 1, bare-bright” scrap only. Coated wire and/or other materials that emit VOC's or similar compounds are never used during melting and casting, cathode is used when required.

Non architectural products can also be made with our bare bright scrap supply however various end uses, specifications, and scrap sources can limit the amount of scrap that can be used to meet our customer's requirements. Cathode usage for these products will depend on scrap quality, availability, location and our casting requirements. **Currently** we are able to use scrap for **80 percent** or more of our requirements, this percentage will vary based on the factors we described and our customer's product mix.

Market conditions dictate when and where recyclable copper is available. Nevertheless, well over 75% of this material is harvested from sources within 500 miles of our plant. Most of these facilities are located in New York State, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, and Southern Ontario. Smaller amounts are harvested from facilities in Southern Maine, New Hampshire, plus the “manufacturing belt” that encompasses Detroit, Toledo, and Cleveland.

Depending upon market conditions the exact percentage of recycled copper and mix of pre-consumer and post-consumer material will vary. Since market conditions vary constantly Revere cannot accurately identify the ratio of pre-consumer to post-consumer copper in a given order. Therefore, Revere has historically used the conservative position that its copper contains only post-industrial material. 2017 industry survey data tells us that producers in North America used roughly 57% pre-consumer scrap and 43% post-consumer scrap.

All of Revere's copper products are made in Rome, NY – approximately 95 miles west of Albany, NY.
